

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Council passed tribal Resolutions No. 56-52 and 56-53, these two resolutions were amending Tribal Ordinances No. 13 and 18 and

WHEREAS, the Constitution and By-Laws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in Article III, Ordinances and Resolutions, Section 2, "All proposed ordinances shall be posted in each district at least 10 days before final action by the Council," this was not complied with.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that this resolution rescind and declare Tribal Resolutions No. 56-52 and 56-53 null and void.

The foregoing resolution was on December 3, 1956 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 934).
