

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the tribal sawmill enterprise now known as Fort Apache Wholesale Lumber Company has a quota of 1,500,000 board feet of timber to be removed from the Cottonwood-Postoffice Logging Unit to be cut before March 31, 1957, and

WHEREAS, snow in the East Fork Logging Unit may stop logging at very short notice,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary of this Council be authorized to execute a contract for the logging and milling of the above-mentioned volume of timber for the Fort Apache Wholesale Lumber Company.

The foregoing Resolution was on February 11, 1957 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
