

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the mineral resources of the Fort Apache Reservation be utilized to the best financial interest of the tribe, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws, that the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency is hereby requested to notify in writing all asbestos mining companies having asbestos claims which are now leased from the White Mountain Apache Tribe and which are in full force and effect begin mining operations within 90 days of date of this resolution and if mines are not actively operating all leases be cancelled according to federal regulations Title 25, CFR,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution does not include asbestos mining leases between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Asbestos Explorations, Inc.

The foregoing resolution was on February 12, 1957 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
