

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe recognizes its responsibilities toward the economic development of the White Mountain Apache people, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe recognizes the dependence upon their irrigated lands now under constructed works on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, Federal funds for operation and maintenance of irrigation structures are granted on a reimbursable basis which are assessed against the land,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that all operation and maintenance expenditures on lands presently under constructed works on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation shall be budgeted in the regular tribal budget from tribal funds.

The foregoing Resolution was on February 18, 1957 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
