


Resolution of the  
White Mountain Apache Tribe of the  
Fort Apache Indian Reservation

WHEREAS, the members of the Miracle Church has applied for a permit to build a church on tribal land in the Seven-Mile District for the purpose of worshipping in their own way, and

WHEREAS, the Miracle Church has approximately four hundred members who have no church for meeting purposes, now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Superintendent of the Agency is hereby authorized to issue a revocable permit authorizing the members of the Miracle Church to use an area of tribal land 210 feet square in the Seven-Mile District.

The foregoing resolution was on February 18, 1957 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
