FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to assist cooperative associations of members of the Tribe, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes its responsibility toward the economic development of its members, and


WHEREAS, the farmers within the Cibecue area have associated into cooperative on February 1, 1957 for the improvement of the social and economic welfare of the community and to develop and improve farming lands in the Cibecue area,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Constitution and By-Laws of the Cibecue Farm Improvement Association are hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman of the Tribal Council is hereby authorized to execute a cooperative agreement with the Cibecue Farm Improvement Association and is directed to make an equipment grant of but not to exceed \$5,000.00.

The foregoing Resolution was on March 4, 1957 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (j) and (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
