

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe passed Resolution No. 53-36 on September 8, 1953 approved a lease on the Iron Mine west of Cibecue in T.9 R15 $\frac{1}{2}$  E on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, this Iron Mine lease, No. 14-20-452-11, in favor of Southwest Lumber Mills, Inc. who state in letter addressed to Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency dated February 12, 1957 that they have exhausted all effort to interest anyone in the deposit, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe agrees with the Southwest Lumber Mills, Inc. that this contract be cancelled,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Council that lease No. 14-20-452-11 with the Southwest Lumber Mills, Inc. be declared null and void.

The foregoing Resolution was on March 4, 1957 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
