

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has appropriated funds for Range Water Development during Fiscal Year 1957, and

WHEREAS, recent drouth conditions has made it imperative to accelerate the development of sources of range water,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman of the Tribal Council be authorized to execute a contract to the lowest bidder for earthmoving and the construction and repair of earth tanks in the Grasshopper area not to exceed \$5,000.00.

The foregoing Resolution was on March 4, 1957 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
