


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, on September 1, 1956, a contract for logging and milling of timber and delivery of lumber from the East Fork Logging Unit was made with Bob Ramsey and Howard Ramsey to be completed on March 31, 1957, and,

WHEREAS, due to adverse weather conditions additional time will be required to complete the last million of the eight million board feet stipulated in this contract,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary of the Tribal Council be authorized to sign an extension contract with Bob Ramsey and Howard Ramsey requiring that the above mentioned contract be completed by June 1, 1957.

The foregoing Resolution was on April 1, 1957 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
