FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, for the period ending March 31, 1958, the Fort Apache Wholesale Lumber Company, a tribal enterprise, will obtain its logs from the following sources:

Cottonwood-Post Office Logging Unit	2,000,000 B. F.
Diamond Creek Spruce- Fir Logging Unit	<u>2,000,000 B. F.</u>
TOTAL	8,000,000 B. F.


which sources are authorized by the Forest Management Plan and,

WHEREAS, new contracts will be required for the logging and milling of this timber and delivery of lumber to the Fort Apache Wholesale Lumber Company plant at Whiteriver, Arizona,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Forest Manager and Plant Manager prepare advertisements requesting bids for the required services, and that the proposals received be received by this Council or Board of Directors and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman and Secretary of this Council be authorized to approve contracts for the services required.

The foregoing Resolution was on May 17, 1957 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
