

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED that the timber from a portion of the Black River Logging Unit, formerly known as the Black River Roadless Area, be prepared for advertisement and sale according to regulations and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that one hundred dollars (\$100.00) be made available for newspaper advertisement and that the Chairman and Secretary of this Council be authorized to sign a contract to cover sale of said timber.

The foregoing Resolution was on May 17, 1957 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
