

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Tribal Resolution 57-20, adopted February 18, 1957, grants authority to the Superintendent to issue a revocable permit to the Miracle Church to use an area of land 210 feet square in the Seven Mile District, and

WHEREAS, because of limitation on account of the right-of-way for Seven Mile road it is necessary that an area of land different than that described in Resolution 57-20 be authorized.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Tribal Resolution 57-20 is hereby amended by deleting the words "210 feet square" in Paragraph 3 and inserting in lieu thereof, the following metes and bounds description:

Commencing at a point 2046.5 feet S 87° 10' E of  
W<sub>1/2</sub> corner of Sec. 31, T.5N, Range 23E, Gila and  
Salt River Meridian, Arizona, thence E 276.2 to a  
fence line, thence following the fence line S 18°  
01' W 227 feet, thence W 132.0 feet, thence N 18°  
30' W 227.3 feet to the point of beginning, contain-  
ing 1.01 acres located within the  $\frac{E}{2}$  of the  $\frac{SW}{4}$  of Sec.  
31 N Range 23E.

The foregoing Resolution was on July 1, 1957 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
