


RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 57-12 dated February 12, 1957 directed the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency to notify all mineral leaseholders that cancellation proceedings would be begun if mines were not in active operation within 90 days of the date of the resolution, and

WHEREAS, Atomic Ores, Inc. of Globe, Arizona, holder of Contract 14-20-452-23 leasing 206.61 acres, has made no effort to get its mine into production and has not otherwise moved to forestall cancellation of the lease.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Branch of Realty, Phoenix Area Office, Bureau of Indian Affairs, be requested to begin and carry through formal cancellation of the Asbestos lease of the said Atomic Ores, Inc.

The foregoing Resolution was on July 19, 1957 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
