

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Arthur Enders, lessee of certain mining claims located on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation commonly designated as White Tail No. 1 and 2 Asbestos Mining Claims, lease number I-30-Ind-2185, and

WHEREAS, the said lease terminated on or about the 2nd day of April, 1957, and

WHEREAS, the said Arthur Enders did not exercise his option to renew said lease but instead executed a release of all his right, title and interest in and to said mining claims to the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, Harry Hagan and Richard Smith of Globe, Gila County, Arizona have applied for a mining lease on the said claims, and

WHEREAS, it would be advantageous to the Tribe to lease said property in order to take advantage of the current Federal asbestos stockpiling program which expires June 30, 1958 by the receipt of royalties from said operations.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session that the Chairman and the Secretary be authorized to execute and sign said lease covering the White Tail No. 1 and 2 mining claims for and on behalf of the Council with Harry Hagan and Richard Smith of Globe, Gila County, Arizona pursuant to all federal regulations governing mining leases on Indian Reservations.

The foregoing Resolution was on August 5, 1957 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
