

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there is need to replace 1955 Ford, two ton livestock truck, motor number F60Z-5L-15061, having a total mileage of 105,000 miles, and

WHEREAS, there is need for transportation of tribal equipment and livestock.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session that the sum of three thousand twenty nine dollars and thirty-four cents (\$3,029.34) is hereby authorized and appropriated from tribal funds on deposit in the IIM Account of the Fort Apache Indian Agency for the purchase of one 1957 Ford, two ton, F600, cabin and chassis, V-8 engine, 172 inch wheel base from Sachs Motor Company, Inc. of Globe, Arizona, this being the lowest and best bid.

The foregoing resolution was on September 9, 1957 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
