

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe, in Resolution No. 55-30, dated the 28th day of September, 1955, joined the National Congress of American Indians; and

WHEREAS, in said Resolution the Tribal Council resolved to pay to said organization the sum of One Hundred Eighty-five and no/100 (\$185.00) Dollars plus 12¢ per person for members; and

WHEREAS, there are now approximately 4,000 members of the Tribe;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Resolution No. 55-30 relative to the annual membership dues payable by the Tribe for joining the National Congress of American Indians be amended as follows, to-wit:

That the membership dues payable to said organization be changed from One Hundred Eighty-five and no/100 (\$185.00) Dollars per year plus 12¢ per person to the sum of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) per year membership, plus 5¢ per person for enrolled members, and that said dues be paid yearly unless membership in said organization is terminated by the Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on the 26th day of September, 1957, duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) and (e) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
