

RESOLUTION OF THE  
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Assembly of God Mission has applied for a permit to use  
 a tract of tribal land in the Carrizo district for mission  
 purposes, and

WHEREAS, the people in the community have indicated their approval of  
 the request.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache  
 Tribe that the Superintendent of the Agency is hereby  
 authorized to issue a revocable permit authorizing the  
 mission to use 0.95 acres of tribal land in the Carrizo  
 District.

The foregoing resolution was on September 27, 1957 duly adopted  
 by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White  
 Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI,  
 Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by  
 the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior  
 on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934  
 (48 Stat. 984).
