

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Forestdale Logging Unit which was approved October 30, 1947 will be completed by March 31, 1958 or earlier, and

WHEREAS, the Forest Management Plan requires that a least seven million board feet be cut annually in the western portion of the reservation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Limestone Logging Unit in the amount of approximately fifteen million board feet be surveyed and advertised for sale according to regulations to the highest bidder.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary be authorized to sign a contract covering such sale of timber and that one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) be authorized to cover advertising expense.

The foregoing resolution was on September 27, 1957 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
