
RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, for many years the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been interested in developing its recreational enterprises, and
- WHEREAS, the construction of a dam across Trout Creek was the ultimate goal to the success of the recreational enterprise of the Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Salt River Valley Water Users' Association, through devious methods and political pressure attempted to prevent the construction of the dam, and
- WHEREAS, Albert M. Hawley, at the risk of his position and at the further risk of being jailed, encouraged the Tribe to complete the construction of the dam, and
- WHEREAS, the said Albert M. Hawley worked tirelessly, conscientiously and ceaselessly, to the extent that he endangered his health, in advancing the social and economic welfare of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe on behalf of its members in appreciation desire to demonstrate their appreciation to their beloved Superintendent, Albert M. Hawley.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session, that the lake impounded behind the Smith Park Dam shall be named "Hawley Lake".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Albert M. Hawley is hereby made and shall hereafter be an honorary member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to enjoy all of its consequential benefits including but without stint lifetime fishing and hunting privileges on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on December 12, 1957, duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n) and (p) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
