

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council passed Resolution No. 56-29 on June 14, 1956 rescinding, reorganizing, renaming and approving a new Plan of Operation for the Fort Apache Wholesale Lumber Company, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Indian Affairs has stipulated that Resolution No. 56-29 is hereby approved upon the following conditions:

1. A commercial audit be made of the operations of the Fort Apache Wholesale Lumber Company not later than July 30, 1957, covering the period from the last commercial audit to June 30, 1957.
2. The enterprise be terminated promptly and other arrangements made satisfactory to the Superintendent and Area Director for the disposition or use of the plant and equipment in the event the enterprise for the period from July 1, 1956 to June 1957, results in a loss.
3. The above conditions be accepted by appropriate resolution of the Tribal Council within 60 days of the date hereof.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the above conditions be unconditionally accepted.

The foregoing Resolution was on January 16, 1957 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (n) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
