


RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, under Public Law 874, as amended, Alchesay High School and elementary school districts on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation are receiving funds for the operation and maintenance of their schools; and
- WHEREAS, said Public Law 874, as amended, will expire on June 30, 1958; and
- WHEREAS, there is now pending in Congress a new version of Public Law 874, as amended, which new version, if enacted, would, after June 30, 1958 estop Alchesay High School and elementary school districts from receiving any funds for the maintenance and operation of their schools; and
- WHEREAS, in order to maintain equal standards of the public school educational facilities on the Indian reservations comparable to the public schools education facilities off the reservation, it is necessary that Public Law 874, as amended, in its present form, be re-enacted;
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Public Law 874, as amended, which law will expire on June 30, 1958 be re-enacted in its present form.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the pending revised version of Public Law 874, as amended, which in effect will supplant the present Public Law 874, as amended, be defeated.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent to each member of the Arizona Congressional delegation, the National Congress of American Indians, Association of American Indian Affairs, Indian Rights Association, Arizona Commission of Indian Affairs, American Friends Service Committee and each Tribal Council of Arizona.

The foregoing resolution was on February 3, 1958 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (a) of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 13, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
