

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, a series of unexpected expenses for the operation of Tribal Police Department vehicles has depleted the funds budgeted for same under Section III (e) of TR 57-30, and

WHEREAS, the unanticipated need for the continued use of extra policemen has also depleted the funds budgeted under Section III (d) Extra Police, of this same TR 57-30,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that in order to provide proper and necessary police protection and transportation, that the sum of nine thousand dollars (\$9,000.) is hereby authorized to be transferred from savings occurring within the budget, TR 57-30, to these accounts in order to complete the fiscal year to June 30, 1958.

The foregoing Resolution was on May 12, 1958 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (e) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
