

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe owns and operates the White Mountain Tribal Herd Enterprise, and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to continue operation of the Enterprise, believing that with the approved Plan of Operation, together with a reasonable and well-planned budget, will allow a profit to be made, and

WHEREAS, the Advisory Committee of the Enterprise has reviewed and approved an operating budget for the calendar year from July 1, 1958 to December 31, 1958.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the said budget in the amount of twenty-seven thousand eight hundred and eighty dollars (\$27,880.00) is hereby approved for the period beginning July 1, 1958 and ending December 31, 1958. Funds for expenditures under said budget are to be from assets now to the credit of the Enterprise in the IIM Accounts of the Fort Apache Agency and from operating revenue during the above mentioned period.

The foregoing resolution was on June 3, 1958 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (e) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
