

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, on May 28, 1958, fire killed timber on Jump Off Canyon Burn Logging Unit, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that this timber be logged as soon as possible

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session that the timber on the Jump Off Canyon Burn Logging Unit be appraised and offered for sale to the highest qualified bidder pursuant to regulations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) be made available for newspaper advertisement and that the Chairman and Secretary of this Council be authorized to sign a contract covering the sale of said timber.

The foregoing resolution was on September 3, 1958, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b), (f) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
