

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Big Cienega Spruce Fir Logging Unit which was approved by the Area Director on March 8, 1957, expired July 1, 1958, and

WHEREAS, the contractor, Henning and Turnbull, have logged 1,068,130 board feet of the estimated 1,100,000 in the Unit, but were unable to complete the work due to adverse road conditions.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the application of the Contractor to extend the completion date of the above contract from July 1, 1958, to December 31, 1958, be granted; however, all other agreements, covenants and stipulations in said contract are to remain in full force and effect.

The foregoing resolution was on September 3, 1958, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b), (f) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
