

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Resolution 58-22 authorized the Bureau of Indian Affairs to enter into an agreement with the U. S. Forest Service to engage the U. S. Forest Service to scale logs from the Maverick Logging Unit on the mill deck of the contractor, Southwest Lumber Mills, Inc., at McNary, Arizona, and

WHEREAS, mill deck scaling would benefit the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary be authorized to sign a cooperative agreement with Southwest Lumber Mills, Inc., providing for the mill deck scaling of logs from the Maverick Logging Unit by the U. S. Forest Service,

The foregoing resolution was on September 3, 1958, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b), (f) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
