

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has entered into many diversified business enterprises, and

WHEREAS, without exception, each of these business enterprises has as its ultimate goal the sale of as many services and products as is economically possible for a profit, and

WHEREAS, it is recognized by similar successful business enterprises off the reservation, as solid business practices, to set aside a certain percentage of income for an advertising program, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has for some time negotiated with different film producers in order to have filmed the activities and results of their lumber, cattle raising, agricultural, and recreational enterprises as well as the products therefrom to be used for advertising purposes, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has the tremendous problem of proving to the public that with the help and guidance of the Bureau further development of these enterprises will make the Tribe less dependent upon the Government for subsistence, and

WHEREAS, investigation has proven that Avalon Daggett Productions of Los Angeles, California, is a qualified film producer.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session that the Tribal Budget for Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 1958 and duly adopted April 9, 1958 by Tribal Resolution 58-17, is hereby amended in the amount of four thousand five hundred and twenty-eight dollars (\$4,528.00) to cover the estimated cost of filming the aforementioned tribal enterprises of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on September 5, 1958 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b), (i), and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
