

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, on July 15, 1958 the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe passed Resolution No. 58-34. Said resolution having as its primary purpose the construction of a sewer line approximately 100 feet in length, which line was to complete off site construction of the Alchesay High School sewer line, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe proposed to pay construction costs from funds available in Account W-91-100, Townsite and Water Main Construction, and

WHEREAS, the Plant Management Branch, Phoenix Area Office, has agreed to assume the entire cost of the off site construction and installation of said sewer line.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Resolution No. 58-34 enacted July 15, 1958 be and the same is hereby rescinded.

The foregoing resolution was on March 4, 1959 duly adopted by a vote of 11 and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
