

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, J. M. Willis, President, Western Hemisphere, 3600 LaHacienda Drive, Northeast, Albuquerque, New Mexico has submitted a request to the Tribal Council for a prospecting permit covering approximately three square miles as per the sketch attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof.

BE IT RESOLVED that a temporary prospecting permit be granted to Western Hemisphere Unlimited for a period of ninety (90) days and covering the area delineated on the attached sketch of said permit.

The foregoing resolution was on April 29, 1959 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
