

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, certain religious denominations conduct revival meetings which meetings extend over a long period of time and into the late evening hours, and

WHEREAS, children attend these meetings, and

WHEREAS, many children who attend these meetings lose needed sleep and thereby become physically exhausted and absent themselves from school, and

WHEREAS, this is detrimental to both the physical and mental well-being of the children.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that no revival meetings shall be held at a later hour than nine o'clock (9:00) p.m.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that before any future revival meetings are approved by the Tribe the religious denominations seeking the meeting shall submit to the Tribal Council the hours in which the revival meeting shall be held.

The foregoing resolution was on April 30, 1959 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
