

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the funds appropriated for range water development, Fiscal Year 1959, have been expended, and

WHEREAS, plans and engineering have been completed for further range water development, and

WHEREAS, present conditions are near critical and the need for immediate action is apparent.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that the sum of Seven thousand dollars (\$7,000.) be transferred from Account W-91-107, T54-18, Gleason Flat Irrigation Project, which funds it is not anticipated will be needed during the present fiscal year to Account W-91-60, Range Water Development.

The foregoing Resolution was on May 18, 1959 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
