

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, on or about August 6, 1956 by Resolution No. 56-39 said resolution being reaffirmed on July 1, 1959, Resolution No. 59-17a said resolution obligating the tribe to pay one-third or approximately \$60,000.00 of the cost of constructing a water and sewerage system for the Whiteriver Community and providing no cost domestic water to the Indians, and

WHEREAS, the Branch of Plant Management and Construction recommended that the above resolution be disapproved and that the Bureau assume the cost of constructing said water and sewerage system.

BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution Nos. 56-39 and 59-17a are hereby rescinded.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs let a contract, as soon as possible, to construct the above-mentioned water and sewerage system near Whiteriver on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation according to approved plans.

The foregoing resolution was on August 5, 1959 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) and (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
