

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there has been correspondence by and between the Tribe and the Central Office of the Bureau of Indian Affairs relative to the contract of our attorney, Barry De Rose, and

WHEREAS, Assistant Commissioner, Thomas M. Reid, by a letter dated August 28, 1959 (Tribal Programs 3224-59) advised the Area Director that before the Commissioner would approve the attorney's contract, that the Tribe and the attorney would have to accept an amendment to said contract requiring the attorney to submit periodic reports to the Tribe and the Commissioner at least every six months, or more frequently when requested by the Tribe or the Commissioner, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribe to accept the recommendation of the Assistant Commissioner.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribe accepts and is agreeable to an amendment to the Tribal Attorney's, Barry De Rose, Contract No. 363 requiring the said attorney to submit periodic reports to the Tribe and the Commissioner at least every six months, or more frequently when requested by the Tribe or the Commissioner.

The foregoing resolution was on September 2, 1959 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (d) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
