

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, on November 6, 1959, the Council by Resolution No. 59-58 established a position of Tribal Forestry Aide, and

WHEREAS, the Area Director advised the Tribe by budget letter dated December 1, 1959 that he was withholding action on the said resolution until the Tribe had time to consider a counter recommendation by the Area Forester contained in said letter, and

WHEREAS, the hiring of a Forestry Aide was urgent due to the Christmas tree season, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe desires to further study the matter and recommendations of the Area Director.

BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution No. 59-58 is hereby rescinded.

The foregoing resolution was on December 16, 1959 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
