

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there is a need to educate the future leaders of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in the proper use and management of their natural resources, and
WHEREAS, the Alchesay High School Vocational Agriculture Department has as its primary aim to training of students in farming and ranching, and
WHEREAS, additional facilities are needed to provide the practical training.
BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the first floor of the dairy barn and south of the barn, as delineated on the attached map, be hereafter used and maintained by the Alchesay High School Vocational Agriculture Department.
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that students designated by the proper school officials have access to these facilities.

The foregoing resolution was on December 16, 1959 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a), (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
