

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, a line cabin located at Burnt Corral and owned by the White Mountain Tribal Herd Enterprise was destroyed by fire, and

WHEREAS, said building was insured against fire with the Heron Insurance Company, Globe, Arizona, and

WHEREAS, said insurance company has offered adjustment in the amount of \$2,874.44 as settlement in full, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Lester Oliver, Chairman, be and is hereby authorized to sign all proofs of loss and other certificates and documents required by the Insurance Company for settlement of this claim.

The foregoing resolution was on December 16, 1959 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
