

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Navajo County desires to obtain screenings for the purpose of highway maintenance in said Navajo County, and

WHEREAS, it is economically beneficial to the Tribe to sell said cinders.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Board of Supervisors of Navajo County be granted a permit to remove cinders from the reservation at the prices in the amounts and at the locality as provided in the contract marked "Exhibit A" attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tribal Council is instructed to sign and the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency, Whiteriver, Arizona, is requested to execute the necessary permit for the removal of cinders in accordance with provisions of Title 25, CFR, as amended, and in compliance with provisions contained herewith.

The foregoing resolution was on December 16, 1959 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
