

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Section 21 of Ordinance No. 32 provides that the Tribal Council shall have the power to license by Resolution, subject to secretarial review, trades or callings not specifically mentioned in the said ordinance and to collect a license tax thereon, and

WHEREAS, the licensing and taxing of theatres and/or movies were omitted from said ordinance.

BE IT RESOLVED that an annual fee shall be paid by every person operating or conducting a theatre or movie establishment on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, in the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said tax or fee shall be paid in advance.

The foregoing resolution was on December 16, 1958 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (o) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
