

Resolution No. 61-4

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, on October 27, 1960 by Resolution No. 60-88 the Tribal Council, among other things, authorized all tribal employees and councilmen be reimbursed at the rate of \$17.00 per diem, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council was of the opinion that only the Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary and Councilmembers should be paid the \$17.00 per diem.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Resolution No. 60-88 be rescinded.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary of the Tribal Council and all Council members be reimbursed at the rate of \$17.00 per diem and ten cents per mile for use of personal vehicles for business transacted off the reservation and the rate of \$3.80 per diem plus ten cents per mile for personal vehicles when assigned to duty away from station but within the boundaries of the reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all other tribal employees be reimbursed at the rate of \$3.80 per diem plus ten cents per mile for personal vehicles when assigned to duty away from station but within boundaries of the reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that employees reimbursed for subsistence and mileage.

The foregoing resolution was on January 4, 1961 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

Dear Mr. Haverland:

Resolution No. 61-4 rescinds Resolution No. 60-88 and resolves that the Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary of the Tribal Council and all Council members be reimbursed at a rate of \$17.00 per day per diem and ten cents per mile for use of private vehicle when on tribal business. The rate of \$3.80 per day per diem plus ten cents per mile for personal vehicles when assigned to duty within the boundary of the Reservation.

Resolution No. 61-4 was enacted on January 4, 1961 by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Tribe's Constitution. Section 1 (k) is subject to the approval of the Secretary and has to do with funds appropriated by the Tribal Council. However, Council members do not expect to exceed the pay and travel expenses as authorized under Section 1 (b) of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Budget for Fiscal Year 1961. It is recommended that this resolution receive favorable action.
