

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Coulter No. 1 Logging Unit will be completed with 60 days, and
WHEREAS, in order to keep timber sales operations as continuous as possible
advance preparations are necessary.

BE IT RESOLVED, that Coulter No. 2 Logging Unit be advertised for bids in
accordance with regulations and that the Chairman and Secretary
be authorized to sign a contract with the successful bidder.

The foregoing resolution was on February 1, 1961 duly adopted by a vote
of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the
Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958
and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

Coulter No. 1 Logging Unit is a small sale and will be completed on or about the first of April. It is our desire to keep timber sale operations on a continuous basis and for this reason we have requested that Coulter No. 2 Logging Unit be advertised.

Resolution No. 61-8 authorizes the advertising of Coulter No. 2 Logging Unit and also authorizes the Chairman and Secretary to sign for and on behalf of the Tribe with successful bidder.

Resolution No. 61-8 was duly enacted on February 1 by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Tribe's Constitution. Under this authority the resolution is not subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior.
