

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, funds provided in Section IV (a).1 of the Tribal Budget for F.Y. 1961 to cover general assistance for indigent tribal members ineligible for Federal and State assistance are depleted and,

WHEREAS, additional funds to cover such assistance are required to the extent of \$8626.12.

BE IT RESOLVED that the balance of \$3626.12 remaining in Section IV (a)2 of the tribal budget is hereby transferred to Section IV (a)1 of said budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the amount of \$5000 is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit in the United States Treasury for transfer to Section IV (a)1 of the Tribe's general budget for Fiscal Year 1961.

The foregoing resolution was on May 4, 1961 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section I (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).



Dear Mr. Haverland:

Attached is Resolution No. 61-42 adopted on May 4, 1961 by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Tribe's Constitution. Under Section 1 (k) the resolution is subject to approval.

This resolution appropriates \$5,000 from tribal funds on deposit in the United States Treasury to cover general assistance for indigent tribal members ineligible for Federal and State assistance. The balance of \$3,636.12 remaining in Section IV (a)2 of the tribal budget was transferred to Section IV (a)1 of the tribal budget for Fiscal Year 1961. This is a transfer of tribal child welfare funds to the general assistance account. The transfer of funds as stated will not cause the child welfare program to suffer as additional funds have been made available from the Bureau of Indian Affairs to meet child welfare needs.

Because of the high incidence of unemployment during the past winter, emergency assistance payments were made to meet the minimum of clothing needs and later was reduced to meet food needs only.

It is recommended that this resolution be approved.
