WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to assist cooperative associations of members of the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes its responsibility toward the economic development of its members, and


WHEREAS, the farmers within the Whiteriver, North Fork, Canyon Day, East Fork and Seven Mile areas have associated into a cooperative on April 4, 1958 for the social and economic welfare of these communities and to develop and improve farming lands in these areas.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman of the Tribal Council is hereby authorized to make a grant of the attached list of tribal-owned farm equipment to the White Mountain Farm Improvement Association.

The foregoing resolution was on June 15, 1961 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Sections (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

Dear Mr. Haverland:

Resolution No. 61-55 was adopted by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe at a regular meeting June 15, 1961, pursuant to Article V, Sections 1 (i) and (k) of the Tribe's constitution. Under Section 1 (k) the Tribe has authority to appropriate tribal funds and to expend such funds in accordance with an annual budget approved by the Secretary of the Interior.

The funds for the purchase of the attached list of farm equipment is in the approved tribal budget of the White Mountain Apache Tribe for fiscal year 1961. It is listed in Section VII - (f) - Reservation Land Improvement. The resolution authorizes the Chairman of the Tribal Council to make the gratuitous grant of the attached list of tribal-owned farm equipment to the White Mountain Farm Improvement Association. It is recommended that this resolution receive favorable action.
