FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 61-47 adopted March 30, 1961 by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council Mr. Paul Simmons was appointed Tribal Treasurer of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and Mr. Lester Oliver, Council Chairman was designated as co-signor of all checks issued by Mr. Simmons, and


WHEREAS, an alternate is required for each of the above.

BE IT RESOLVED that Mrs. Genevieve B. Truax is designated as deputy Tribal Treasurer to act only during the temporary absence of Mr. Paul Simmons and is directed to secure bond in the amount of \$75,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mrs. Mary C. Endfield is designated as alternate co-signor to act only in the temporary absence of Mr. Lester Oliver and is directed to secure bond in the amount of \$10,000.

The foregoing resolution was on June 28, 1961 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Article I, Section 4 (a), (c) and (d) of the Amended By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat 984).

Dear Mr. Haverland:

Resolution No. 61-67 was adopted by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council on June 28, 1961 pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Article 1, Section 4 (a), (c) and (d) of the Amended By-Laws of the Tribe.

This Resolution designates Mrs. Genevieve B. Truax to act as Deputy Tribal Treasurer during the temporary absence of Mr. Paul Simmons, Tribal Treasurer. It also designates Mrs. Mary C. Endfield to act as co-signor of all checks during the temporary absence of Mr. Lester Oliver, Tribal Chairman.

The Resolution further provides that the deputy treasurer and the alternate co-signor secure bonds in the amount of \$75,000 and \$10,000 respectively. Such bonds have been applied for.

Under the authorities quoted the Resolution is not subject to approval. The bonds, however, are subject to approval and will be forwarded immediately upon receipt at this Agency.
