

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 61-59 authorized, among other things, the Chairman to enter into a contract with the Board of Regents of the Universities and State College of Arizona, and

WHEREAS, contract provided that before the register was completed, another contract would have been entered into, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe does not feel that it is in a position to expend additional funds over and above the Four Thousand (\$4,000.00) Dollars to complete the register.

BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution No. 61-59 is rescinded.

The foregoing resolution was on June 28, 1961 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

Dear Mr. Haverland:

It will be recalled that Tribal Resolution No. 61-59 authorized the Chairman to enter into a contract with the Board of Regents of the University of Arizona for the purpose of establishing a population register for the White Mountain Apache Tribe. The Tribal Attorney objected to the proposed contract for a population register and advised the Council that they would have to expend an additional \$4,000 to complete the above-mentioned register. He also recommended that Resolution No. 61-59 be rescinded.

Resolution No. 61-72 was enacted on June 28, 1961 by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to Article V, Section 1 (b) of the Tribe's constitution. This resolution is not inconsistent with law or this constitution and therefore not subject to review and approval of the Secretary of the Interior.
