

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints has applied for a permit to use a tract of tribal land in the Cibecue District for mission purposes, and

WHEREAS, the people in the community had indicated of their desire to have the Tribal Council approve the request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency is hereby authorized and requested to issue a revocable permit authorizing the mission to use the following described tribal land in the Cibecue District for mission purposes:

Commencing at Station 0+00 on the centerline of the Cibecue to Highway 60 road, thence N. 88°00'E., 52.78 feet to Station 0+52.78; thence N. 5°38'W., 970.00 feet along the center line of a 50' road; thence N. 87°27'E., 288.10 feet; thence N.3°00'W., 2273.20 feet along the centerline of a 50' road; thence S.83°39'E., 189.65 feet to the point of beginning. Thence S.83°39'E., 185.00 feet; thence S.15°21'W., 100.00 feet; thence N.83°39'W., 185.00 feet; thence N.15°21'E., 100.00 feet to the point of beginning.

The foregoing resolution was on August 3, 1961 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 3 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

Dear Mr. Haverland:

Resolution No. 61-62 resolves that the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency be authorized to issue a revocable permit to the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints. This tract of land is located in the Cibecue community and defined by a metes and bounds description.

On December 16, 1959 the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe enacted Resolution No. 59-65 authorizing the Superintendent to issue a revocable permit to the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints for the use of approximately one acre of ground in the Cibecue community.

At the present time, I do not know whether the Tribe intends to allow the LDS Church to build two missions in this district. The revocable permit became effective December 16, 1959 and will terminate on December 15, 1960. The Council will meet on September 6, and I will request the Chairman to bring before the Council the fact that the Tribe has issued two revocable permits to the LDS Church in the Cibecue District.

The resolution was enacted on August 3, 1961 by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Tribe's Constitution. Under this authority the resolution is not subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior.
