

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Chlerson-Reidhead Logging Company is nearing completion of the Limestone Logging Unit which began in 1958, and

WHEREAS, additional mature timber in need of harvesting is located in Survey Units 5 and 6, and

WHEREAS, the tribe desires the logs from Units 5 and 6 to be milled at Carrizo Mill.

BE IT RESOLVED that a logging unit be prepared according to regulations for advertisement and bids in Survey 5 or 6 as may be found most advantageous to forest road development and fire protection; and that the Chairman and Secretary be authorized to sign contracts covering sales of such timber.

The foregoing resolution was on August 3, 1961 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

Resolution No. 61-83 resolves that a logging unit be prepared for advertisement and bids in Survey Unit 5 or 6, and also authorizes the Chairman and Secretary to sign contracts for and on behalf of the Tribe.

The resolution was adopted on August 3, 1961 by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Tribe's Constitution. Under this authority the resolution is not subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior.
