FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council appropriated funds for trail camp, and

WHEREAS, the Council was unable to find college students interested in this type of summer work.

BE IT RESOLVED that monies appropriated for Fiscal Year 1962, Tribal Resolution No. 61-39, Section X - Education (c) Trail Camp For College Students - \$3,520.00 be transferred to Section X - Education (b) Youth Camp and Youth Summer Work Program.

The foregoing resolution was on August 3, 1961 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

Dear Mr. Haverland:

Resolution No. 61-85 resolves that the monies appropriated for Fiscal Year 1962 by Resolution No. 61-39 be transferred from Trail Camp for College Students to Youth Camp and Summer Work Program. This transfer is in Section X of the Tribal Budget.

The resolution was enacted on August 3, 1961 pursuant to authority vested in Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Tribe's Constitution. Under this authority the Tribe can appropriate funds for tribal purposes and expend such funds in accordance with an annual budget approved by the Secretary of the Interior. However, this resolution does not appropriate any new monies, therefore, it is not subject to review or approval.
