

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 56-22, May 12, 1956 authorized the scaling of Haverick Logging Unit logs at the Southwest Forest Industries, Inc., mill deck at McNary, Arizona where the scaling is done by the U. S. Forest Service by agreement with the Bureau, and

WHEREAS, the Southwest Forest Industries, Inc., has a contract covering the Coulter No. 2 Logging Unit, which timber can be properly and economically mill decked scaled in the same manner at McNary.

BE IT RESOLVED that timber from the Coulter No. 2 Logging Unit and any other units contracted for by Southwest Forest Industries, Inc., may be scaled in the above mentioned manner if so recommended by the Bureau and agreed upon by the said Southwest Forest Industries, Inc.

The foregoing resolution was on September 6, 1961 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
