RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Fred H. Haverland, Phoenix Area Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, by letter of August 24, 1961 refused to approve Resolution No. 61-88, and

WHEREAS, the reason stated in the said letter are meritorious.

BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution No. 61-88 is hereby rescinded.

The foregoing resolution was on September 6, 1961 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 964).
