

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe receives great benefit by its membership in the National Congress of American Indians, and

WHEREAS, the National Convention of the National Congress of American Indians will be held in Lewiston, Idaho from the 18th through the 23rd of September, 1961.

BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribe pay the annual membership dues of the National Congress of American Indians in the amount of \$1250.00 from their tribal funds.

BE IT RESOLVED that Lester Oliver, Ida Early, Clinton Kessay, Fred Banashley are hereby delegated to represent the White Mountain Apache Tribe in the Annual Convention of the National Congress of American Indians at Lewiston, Idaho the 18th of September through the 23rd day of September, 1961.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Attorney, Barry De Rose is delegated to attend the said conference, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Area Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs authorize Albert M. Hawley, Superintendent, Fort Apache Indian Agency to attend said convention.

The foregoing resolution was on September 7, 1961 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

It further resolves that the Tribal Attorney, Barry DeRose, be delegated to attend the annual convention of the National Congress of American Indians. It further resolves that the Area Director authorize the Fort Apache Agency Superintendent to attend the convention.
